Whereas; the United States Postal Service has announced as part of an overall service Standards change allowing the Postal Service to reduce operating cost by 20 billion dollars by 2015, and

Whereas; the Eatontown Distribution Center serves an essential function here in Monmouth County, New Jersey and

Whereas; the loss of services provided by the Eatontown facility will have a detrimental effect on local businesses, organizations and families throughout the New Jersey shore Region, and

Whereas; the closure of the Eatontown Distribution Center will be a disservice to all the residents of Monmouth County and its fifty-three municipalities, and


Whereas; the closure of the Eatontown Distribution Center will cause checks, contracts and bills payments to be delayed and will cause late charges or worse, and

Whereas; the American people have come to rely on the United Postal Service for the delivery of their life sustaining medications, and

Whereas; the United State Postal Service has failed to notify the Borough of Lake Como and the surrounding communities of the negative impact of the proposed postal changes.

Now, therefore be it resolved; that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Lake Como request the Congress of the United States to address the problems of the United States Postal Service and work to avoid the closure of the Eatontown, New Jersey Distribution Center.
